OUR EYFS

Questa settimana abbiamo parlato di alcuni mestieri che aiutano la nostra comunità. In particolare ci siamo focalizzati sul mestiere dell'operatore ecologico.

OUR EYFS

The children have started exploring planet Earth focusing on where we live and paying special attention to how the planet is mostly covered by water.

As the weeks progress the children will be exploring aspects of the ocean including how to look after it and how to keep safe when they are around a body of water.



The children also had the opportunity to interact with shells, including exploring their textures, colours and shape before using art materials and methods to paint versions of them for their 'Under the sea' display.

Inoltre, per prepararci alla festa della mamma, che in Italia si festeggia l'8 Maggio, abbiamo fatto conversazioni sulle nostre mamme, soffermandoci a riflettere cosa fanno per noi e tutti quei lavori che si fanno in casa. Da qui abbiamo pensato a cosa possiamo fare noi per aiutare in casa mamma e papà, disegnandolo e raccontandolo.

This week the children have completed their journey in the holy religious month of Ramadan.

The children were particularly interested in how muslims fast and the meaning behind it. This led to them creating their own pieces of work that represented the rising and setting of the sun.



The children also spent time exploring different structures of Mosques before creating their versions.

Their work is now on display for them to enjoy.



OUR EYFS

Like our postal workers, we have been busy in reception.

We are learning about postal workers and how they deliver messages (communication) to us.

Currently, we are at the beginning stage of turning our classroom into a post/sorting office.

This week they listened to a story about a postman. From this story the children learned about sending and receiving mail. They now know that the postal workers deliver our mail directly to our homes and businesses. They understand that the mail doesn't only include letters but also parcels and packages.

They also learned about the various modes of transport that are used during the delivery process.

They will next learn about how messages were delivered in the past and they will look at post boxes in their environment and compare them to other countries.

The children were then encouraged to create a postal worker for a display.

Since it was Earth Day this past weekend, we discussed this event as a group and shared our thoughts and opinions. Our little ones are very aware of the problems that we are currently experiencing. They understood and used appropriate vocabulary to express their feelings about the issues that we face.

So, we made a pledge to contribute towards making things better by using our own two hands to do things such as turning off the lights when they are not in use and recycling water.





Year 1 – Science

We then created our own Lego figure.








Year 2 – History/Literacy

KS2 Police visit

Two policemen came and visited our KS2 children.

2. Peer pressure: be a strong person, do what you want to do and not what the others are pushing you to do.
3. Don't talk to strangers and don't accept anything from strangers







They did this by noting that when parts are joined together they make up one whole by using their connections to the world through food; examples of slices of cake, pizza and fruits being sliced and segments of chocolate bars.

They understood each part of a fraction, that the denominator told us how many parts made up our whole and that the numerator showed how many parts we had used.



OUR KS2


