







#### Year 2 – ART with Ms C. Forbes

Lots of nature and a tree". - Leonardo



Year 3 has been exploring the different forces of push and pull that act upon different objects.

They thought of items in everyday life that required a force to make the object function. Next they had a discussion about which they would demonstrate to the rest of the class as a freeze frame. The children acted out the following forces. Pushing a lawn mower, pushing themselves on a playground swing, pulling the air swing, pushing a baby in a pram and pulling open a door. Finally, they were given different images to draw and were asked to identify the force acting on each and whether the force made the object start or stop.
