OUR EYFS



Early years have been playing with water this week. The water trays were set up to suit their play with the addition of colourful water beads and toys.

Whilst playing with the water, the children were encouraged to listen to a variety of stories, which included, Water, Water Everywhere, Hey Water, Cussly Learn To Save Water and Why Should I Save Water which then led to us discussing the importance of water, how and when we use it and learned the names of various bodies of water. They were encouraged to demonstrate their understanding by drawing some pictures.

The children also enjoyed filling and emptying buckets of water as they attempted to fill a water tray outside on the patio.

They were encouraged to use number names and count in sequence as they took turns filling their little buckets and emptying into the big water tray. We counted to 40 before recycling the water. Again, they took turns re-filling their buckets as they water the plants.



The children had fun doing this activity.

"This is so much fun," yelled some of them as they went back and forth watering the plants.

Abbiamo quindi notato la differenza tra la nostra respirazione e quella dei pesci e capito come questi riescano a respirare nell'acqua.



Year 3 & Year 4 – Maths

This week both year groups have completed a long week of Maths tests which has allowed them to demonstrate a range of mathematical knowledge, skills and approaches. Year 3 and Year 4 have answered a range of questions on time of a 12 and 24 hour clock in both analogue and digital formats and shape, where the children answered questions on shape families, shape dimensions, lines of symmetry and translation. They also had questions that asked them to deal with money and real life money calculations. Finally, they showed their understanding of statistics by using pictograms, keys, charts, bar and line graphs and two-way tables to complete their questions. They all worked very hard and were all extremely proud to have finished the maths curriculum early.

Year 5 & Year 6 – Una giornata STORICA


Giornata di immersione nella storia! Come?
