<p>EYFS Sports Club – The Spanish Way FC @ school - in English.</p>	 <p>The club is led by the tutor from The Spanish Way. Children will explore six different sports throughout the year, developing basic skills in each.</p> <p>Sessions take place in the school hall from 3pm to 4pm. <p>KS1- 7+ - Ms Leah - in English.</p>	<p>7+ Preparation Club is designed to support children through the challenging entrance exam process with confidence. The club offers focused, engaging sessions that develop key skills in English, maths, and reasoning. Children will build strong foundations in reading comprehension, writing, arithmetic, and problem-solving, while also learning effective exam strategies such as time management and tackling unfamiliar questions. With personalised feedback, and a supportive learning environment, this club helps children feel prepared, motivated, and ready to succeed.</p> <p>Students will be asked to purchase specific books for use in sessions and at home.</p>
<p>KS1-KS2 – STEM – Ms Cayne</p>	<p>Children will engage in a diverse a mixture of projects to cover various STEM areas of learning (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), e.g. Rubber Band Propeller Cart (Elastic Potential Energy / Newton's 3rd Law of Motion); Pinball Machine (Gravity on a Incline / Friction); Zoetrope (Light / Eye); Cardboard Ratchet Mechanism (Mechanics); Electromagnet (Electricity / Electromagnetism). Each session starts with a discussion of the science principles behind the project selected for this session. Children are guided through the construction, while discussing engineering aspects of it. Each session ends with some kind of a testing.</p>
